AHME Salary Survey: Emerging from the Pandemic and Navigating our New Roles

AHME has conducted a GME Professionals' Salary Survey every three years, on average, for the last several decades. This information has always proven to be of great value to our members, as they advocate (or self-advocate) for compensation reflective of the incredibly complex work undertaken by GME Professionals. By reporting the results of our 2021 Survey – with some additional demographic data – we will describe the current challenges and resilience of this incredible group of individuals.

Objectives:

- Determine the national compensation comparison according to multiple metrics (length of time in medical education, scope of responsibilities, educational level, geographic location, job title, etc.);
- Construct data-driven rationale for possible adjustment to compensation; and,
- Describe current state of GME professional workforce (including remote vs. in-person work, funding for professional development activities, resources for reducing burnout and building resilience, etc.) to better align yourself with colleagues.
